With over 1,320 acres of skiable terrain at over 7,000 feet, Terry Peak offers skiing for everyone.



DEADWOOD





Weather

Due to its location at the base of the Northern Black Hills and proximity to the semi-arid High Plains to the North, Spearfish has a unique climate for its latitude. Using the Koppen climate classification system, Spearfish has a humid subtropical climate (Cfa) that borders on a Mediterranean-influenced continental climate (Dsa) as summers are quite dry.

Spearfish has four distinct seasons, a hot and dry summer, a temperate fall and spring, and moderately cold and snowy winter. Winters in Spearfish are variable and often temperate as the area benefits from warm Chinook winds that come downward into the valley from the Northern Hills.

It is not uncommon to have 50-60 degree days in January and February and snow cover rarely lasts long in the valley.

Excluding sporadic cold and heat fronts during winter and summer months, Spearfish has temperate weather and can be enjoyed year around. A similar climate to Spearfish is Salt Lake City, Utah which is also located in a transitional zone.

FAQs

WHAT IS THREE PEAKS RANCH?

Three Peaks Ranch (TPR) is a 571 acre community located in Lawrence County, South Dakota. Right off Interstate 90, Three Peaks Ranch is approximately a 15-minute drive from Spearfish, South Dakota, and less than an hour from two airports.

WHO OWNS THREE PEAKS RANCH?

HOW MANY LOTS WILL BE AT THREE PEAKS RANCH?

The community will include 55 total 2-54 acre ranch lots.

WHAT IS THE ZONING FROM THREE PEAKS RANCH AND WHAT IS GOVERNING AUTHORITY?

Lawrence County South Dakota is the governing authority for the property. The zoning has been determined as (51) Park Forest (1978) lots and (4) 41.5+ acre A1 (General Agriculture 1978) lots.

WHAT INFRASTRUCTURE WILL BE DELIVERED WITH THREE PEAKS RANCH?

All lots will be served with water provided by the City of Whitewood (www.cityofwhitewood.net), high speed fiber provided by Blue Peak (www.mybluepeak.com), electric provided by Butte Electric Cooperative (www.butteelectric.com) and a 24' wide asphalt access road. Butte Electric Cooperative will provide a transformer to each lot upon application by owner.

WHEN WILL INFRASTRUCTURE BE COMPLETE?

All infrastructure has been completed.

HAS A FIRE MITIGATION PLAN BEEN COMPLETED AND IMPLEMENTED PER LAWRENCE COUNTY ORDINANCE?

ARE THERE COVENANTS, CODES AND RESTRICTIONS (CCRS) FOR THREE PEAKS RANCH?

WHAT IS THE COST OF WATER FROM THE CITY OF WHITEWOOD?

The water system serving Three Peaks Ranch, which has 55 platted lots, also serves the neighboring communities of Spearfish Mountain Ranch which has 27 platted lots, and Wildflower Estates which has 31 platted lots. A water association has been formed to manage the system. The cost to manage the system will be divided by the total number of lots in the three communities which is 113 and invoiced monthly beginning May 1, 2026. This cost is in addition to the cost of water as charged by the City of Whitewood. The water association will read meters at each lot each month and invoice based on usage.

WILL PICK UP MY TRASH?

A third-party vendor will be engaged by the HOA to pick up trash at the entrance of each lot.

WHAT IS SOURCE OF ENERGY FOR COOKING & HEAT?


Propane. Buyers will be responsible for cost to buy and bury a propane tank(s) and to purchase propane.

Iconic Events and Outdoor Adventures


South Dakota offers a variety of outdoor events that celebrate its breathtaking landscapes and historic landmarks.


At Mount Rushmore National Memorial, visitors can experience patriotic gatherings, including the Independence Day Celebration, which features reenactments, performances, and tributes to American history.

In Custer State Park, the Buffalo Roundup is one of the most thrilling outdoor events, drawing thousands of spectators each fall. Cowboys and park rangers on horseback drive a massive herd of bison across the plains, a spectacle that helps manage the population while preserving South Dakota's frontier spirit.
